SUMMARY OF THE REASONS FOR DECISION:

The DVD entitled *Puni Puni Poemy* is classified as:
Objectionable.

This classification is due to the publication tending to promote and support the exploitation of children and young persons for sexual purposes, and to a lesser extent, sexual coercion, as defined under s3(2) of the Films, Videos, and Publications Classification Act 1993 (FVPC Act).

The publication, which is a Japanese anime, attributes adult sexual characteristics and behaviours to characters who are children and young persons. These characters are engaged in sexual activity, including coercive activity, for the purposes of entertainment and titillation. This serves to reinforce the notion that sexual activity involving children and young persons is both legitimate and socially acceptable.

This classification is consistent with Parliament's intention that publications falling under s3(2) of the FVPC Act are deemed objectionable.
